## SAFETY FIRST BASIC SAFETY RULES

- Make sure you are in an appropriate mental and physical condition when at work.
- Make sure you are adequately trained before performing any activity.
- Think about possible risks before starting any activity. Stop the work and seek your supervisor's advice if you notice an unforeseen or unacceptable risk.

- Follow the procedures and never take short-cuts.
- Wear the required PPE and never modify them.
- Use a fall protection system when working at height.

- Use correctly the appropriate tools and safety devices. Never modify or remove them.
- Use lock-outs and de-energize the machinery before working on equipment or entering restricted areas.
- Operate equipment and vehicles only if you hold the proper license and follow the traffic rules.

- Maintain a safe distance from moving vehicles.
- Never stand under or near a suspended load. When operating cranes, keep your eye on the load.
- Report all accidents, incidents, near-misses and unsafe behavior/conditions.
